



## HEALTH

Despite an increased level of funding our Health service is in chaos. Accident & Emergency Units are unable to cope.

Waiting lists are far too long. A Community Hospital for Tuam is essential. The whole system is bogged down in unnecessary bureaucracy.

## **CHILD CARE**

As a provider of childcare facilities within housing developments I will lobby for grant aid and Tax Relief for young parents and press for the reduction of excise duties on essential items.

## **EDUCATION & TRAINING**

I believe that all young people should have access to education, training and career guidance so that particular interests and abilities are catered for.

## **TRANSPORT & INFRASTRUCTURE MY AIMS ARE:**

- Provision of new roads and road improvements;
- To provide the re-opening of the Western Rail Corridor;
- Extension of the Broadband System;
- Enhancement of water supply, sewerage and waste water treatment facilities within our towns and villages;

## **HOUSING**

I will endeavour to ensure a greater supply of affordable housing for first time buyers and for people who have become home owners within the past five years, I will demand a refund of Vat on a tiered basis.

## **AGRICULTURE/ENERGY**

I will support strategies, which promote markets for agricultural produce especially dairy and meat supplies.

Alternative energy sources need to be researched and developed. Our over dependency on fossil fuels particularly oil cannot continue indefinitely. The production of alternative energy must be vigorously pursued immediately.

## **LAW & ORDER**

The scale of law and order offences and crime are of great concern to me. My first priority is to provide extra Gardaí on the streets to ensure greater security within our communities and also put measures in place to deal with the carnage on our roads.
